GENERAL INFORMATION

Curaçao is a Lesser Antilles island in the Southern Caribbean Sea and the Dutch Caribbean region. It is located about 50 km from the northwestern coast of Venezuela. Up until 2010, Curaçao was considered a part of the Netherlands.

Geography: Curaçao lies on the continental shelf of South America. The highest point of the island is Sint Christoffelberg. The coastlines bays, inlets and hot springs offer an on-site source of natural mineral, thermal, or seawater used in hydrotherapy and mesotherapy.

   **Climate:** Curaçao has a tropical savannah climate, with a dry season from January to September and a wet season from October to December. The temperatures are relatively constant with small differences throughout the year. The year's average minimum temperature is 25.3 °C (78 °F).
